Module Goals

Module CAD *ECDL CAD*, requires the candidate to demonstrate competency in using some of the standard available features of a CAD application to create and manipulate objects or elements and to modify objects or elements. The candidate shall also be able to change object properties, to undertake printing or plotting activity associated with the delivery of outputs. The candidate is also required to demonstrate competency in using some of the more advanced features of CAD applications software such as inserting objects from other applications.
